**St. John Fisher College Dedicates Classroom in Honor of \$120,000
Grant Received from RG&E for Wegmans School of Pharmacy**

PITTSFORD, N.Y., March 29, 2007—St. John Fisher College announced today that it has dedicated a classroom in the Wegmans School of Pharmacy in honor of a \$120,000 grant received from Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (RG&E). The gift was made possible through RG&E’s Capital Investment Incentive Program.

“We continue to be grateful for the support of our community partners,” said Dr. Donald Bain, President, St. John Fisher College. “This classroom in the Wegmans School of Pharmacy will serve as a lasting reminder of RG&E’s generosity.”

With help from Project Manager Joseph Burkart, the grant was awarded to fund electrical improvements at the Wegmans School of Pharmacy, and was used to install duct banks, switchgear, transformers, and feeders within the recently constructed building.

“Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation very much appreciates this recognition by St. John Fisher College and is pleased to provide economic development assistance for this new facility,” said Jim Laurito, RG&E’s president and CEO. “With the new Wegmans School of Pharmacy, RG&E clearly recognizes Fisher’s efforts to fulfill a need in our region by broadening its educational opportunities in the area of health care.”

RG&E's Capital Investment Incentive Program provides funding assistance of up to \$300,000 per project for capital investments of \$1 million or greater to fund electric improvements on either RG&E-owned or customer-owned equipment. Funds are targeted for business projects that involve major capital investment in plant and equipment. The monthly incremental electric demand after capital investment must be at least 100 kilowatts.

This assistance is part of a commitment by RG&E to spend \$65 million from economic development funds through 2008 to help businesses grow and to attract new businesses to the region.
